7. ANTI SOCIAL BEHAVIOUR, CRIME AND POLICING ACT 2014

Consideration was given to the draft report of the Assistant Director Community Services which set out details of the Anti-Social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014 in preparation for the implementation on 20 October 2014. - Steps/processes from initial complaint to conclusion / prosecution.
- Logging complaints (alternative modes of communication email, text, frequency of contact.)

In response to the query related to complaints regarding to the grass cutting schedule at parks, the Assistant Director Housing and Regeneration made an undertaking to pass this observation through to the Assistant Director Street Scene.
