Article 4 Direction Ormskirk, Aughton and Westhead

Additional Information provided by the Acting Executive Manager Planning at Planning Committee on 11 November 2010:

"I have received further information which calls into question the accuracy of the number of students studying at the University as referred to in paragraph 5.1 of the report. The following information has been submitted by South Lathom Residents' Association and is a copy of a letter from Dr Hutchinson-Howorth, the University's Director of Strategic Planning.

"Our analysis of the student cohort by location of study indicates that 15,193 students undertake their primary studies on the campus based in Ormskirk. Of these 7,369 are full time students whilst 7,824 study on a part time basis. Of the remaining student cohort 8,118 students have our Woodlands centre in Chorley as their identified key study area and although much of their work is undertaken off site they may from time to time be required to visit the Ormskirk campus for elements of their study or support. The remaining student cohort is distributed mainly in the North West of England with student populations between 150 and 200 located at Bury, Manchester, Shrewsbury and Trafford. We have around 90 students who undertake distance based study".
