The CSP is satisfied that there is insufficient evidence to support the introduction of an EMRO. The CSP already has a partner group working together to reduce the issues encountered on St Helens Road and has, through its Local Priorities Group supported the Student's Union SSHH campaign in the past. Additionally, there is also a group that looks at the issues encountered by residents and students in "Fresher's Week". Individual partners of the CSP have been asked to respond and they will provide a response appropriate for their organisation. The key CSP partner in relation to this issue is Lancashire Constabulary and we are aware of their reluctance to the introduction of the EMRO. The CSP would support the response provided by the Police in principle.
