I have been a manager at Disraelis
for 18 years, we employ an average of 16
staff 8 of which are full time. Although
we do close earlier than other pubs in
the town centre a E.M.R.O would have
a effect on our business as customers would
go outside of the area for a evening out.

Ormskirk town centre has never
looked as bad as it does at the moment
with every 3rd shop closed. The business
rates the Council must be loosing, will
only get worse, as struggling Licensing
Premises will close.

It worries me that with a large percentage of housing stock being rented by students who do not pay Council tax, where the money will come from for street cleaning, schools & policing etc.

They must be alternatives to this decision. I'm sure working with Landlords, Residents, police and most importantly Edge Hill University a compromise could be found.

A. E.M.P.O. would in my experience make the situation worse with revellers returning home from nights out and still being rowdy at least in Ormskirk we have sensible pricing policy in place as well as trained Bluff/Bar staff

and a good .C.E.T.V program
in operation.
