Thank you for consulting me with regard to this premises licence application.

I discussed with the applicant that I felt that some of the risks to the prevention of the public nuisance objective were not fully covered and so the applicant has agreed to accept the following conditions:

- 1) All external doors and windows shall be kept closed when regulated entertainment is being provided except in the event of an emergency.
- 2) No live music or entertainment shall be permitted on the premises at any time.
- 3) Notices shall be displayed at public exits, in a clear and prominent position, requesting that patrons respect the needs of local residents and leave the premises and the area quietly.
- 4) The Designated Premises Supervisor and other members of staff to request customers to leave quietly and have respect for their residential neighbours.
- 5) Noise from music and associated sources shall not be audible at the boundary of any neighbouring residential premises after 18:00 hours any day.
- 6) No deliveries will take place between the hours of 20:00 and 08:00 hours.
- 7) The placing of refuse, such as bottles, into receptacles outside the premises shall take place between 08:00 and 20:00 only, so as to prevent disturbance to nearby premises.

- 8) The Designated Premises Supervisor shall ensure that staff arriving early morning or departing late at night when the business has ceased trading conduct themselves in such a manner to avoid disturbance to nearby residents.

On the basis of the agreement to accept the above conditions to form part of the premises licence I have no objection to the granting of a new premises licence.
