Good afternoon,

I have been asked to submit a representation regarding your application for a new premises licence for Two Cents Pizza Ltd. I don't have any major concerns with the application as the hours appear reasonable and we have not received any noise related complaints. However, in line with other premises licences I would like to propose some additional conditions to fully cover the public nuisance objective, as these are the standard ones we usually require. As such it would be useful if we could agree these upfront prior to me sending my formal response to our Licensing team.

- 1) All external doors and windows shall be kept closed when regulated entertainment is being provided except in the event of an emergency.
- 2) No live music or entertainment shall be permitted on the premises at any time.
- 3) Notices shall be displayed at public exits, in a clear and prominent position, requesting that patrons respect the needs of local residents and leave the premises and the area quietly.
- 4) The Designated Premises Supervisor and other members of staff to request customers to leave quietly and have respect for their residential neighbours.
- 5) Noise from music and associated sources shall not be audible at the boundary of any neighbouring residential premises after 18:00 hours any day.
- 6) No deliveries will take place between the hours of 20:00 and 08:00 hours.
- 7) The placing of refuse, such as bottles, into receptacles outside the premises shall take place between 08:00 and 20:00 only, so as to prevent disturbance to nearby premises.

- 8) The Designated Premises Supervisor shall ensure that staff arriving early morning or departing late at night when the business has ceased trading conduct themselves in such a manner to avoid disturbance to nearby residents.

I would be grateful if you would consider these conditions and let me know what you think before Tuesday 15th October 2019 as this is when I am due to submit my response to Licensing. Please feel free to give me a call should you wish to discuss further.
