Topics can cover any area of the Borough Council's work, and in some cases the work of Partner Organisations that might have significance for the local community in West Lancashire. The reviews carried out by the Committee provide a valuable insight into issues facing local communities and can assist the work of the Council. Reviews in previous years have covered a wide range of topics including Climate Change, Litter Bin Policy and more recently the Financial Inclusion Strategy, to name but a few.
