**SUBJECT: Applications For Works To TPO Trees Determined Under The Delegated System – 06/11/2021 to 10/12/2021**

WARD:- Aughton And Downholland

Application: T/2021/0137/TPO Decision: Grant Consent Subject to conditions (T)

Proposal: T58 - Oak. Remove split branches. Reason: Large stem wounds with incipient decay. Epicormic growths on main stem over car park. Split branches over car park area. T1976 - Oak. Remove major deadwood. Crown lift to 5m over car park. Reason: Asymmetrical crown due to adjacent trees. Significant deadwood present. Low branches over car park area. T42-Oak. Remove significant deadwood. Crown lift to 5m over car park. Reduce limb with hazard beam by 20%. Reason: Branch with hazard beam at 5m. Deadwood. Low branches over car park area. T1975 - Horse Chestnut. Crown lift to 5m over car park. Reason: Low branches over car park. T1978 - Beech. Crown lift to 5m over car park. Reason: Low branches. G3 - Beech x 3, Lime x 2, Horse Chestnut x 1 - Crown lift to 5m over car park. Clear buildings by up to 2m where required. Reason: Some evidence of minor dieback. Minor deadwood, branches in close proximity to building. Low branches over car park. G4 - Sycamore, Horse Chestnut and Lime. Crown lift to 5m over car park. Reason: Stem wounds with incipient decay. Included unions and deadwood present. Low branches over car park. G6a - Elm. Remove. Reason: In extensive decline. Suspected Dutch elm disease. Not expected to live beyond two years. G7 - Beech x 2, Holly x 2. Clear building by 2m. Reason: Branches touching building.

T2 Oak - prune back to growth points 3m to clear building. Crown thin 20%

Proposal: T1 - Ash - fell. Reason: Due to stem strangulation by chain with all crown parts above chain dead. T2 - Sycamore - fell. Reason: As a preventative H&S measure due to stem strangulation by chain. Replant two trees within the garden at site; species to be confirmed by client.

Proposal: 1 x Ash tree. Removal. Reason. It has been monitored for 3 years and has a large, north facing basal cavity on a former stem and a smaller cavity on the main stem with evidence of Daldinia fungi. At ground level there is Physcalacriaceae fungi and signs of cracking on the stem. The tree has got Ash die back and is leaning towards the single track road. A Sycamore tree will be planted in place of the removed tree.

Proposal: Fell the tree (Willow) shown on the attached plan. The tree has already had permission from the officer to fell which has lapsed. The tree was identified by the officer as previously being in poor condition. The tree to fell is in the area located on the attached plan as submitted to the Council and as shown, identified on the enclosed photograph which shows a twin stemmed tree. Reason: One stem with an area of decay visible on the trunk and the adjacent stem/trunk with a split hanging limb. To remove one Willow tree from the site that was agreed and permission has lapsed.
