There was a night club at the same venue a few years ago which caused horrendous problems for local residents, and our concern is that the application is just a ruse for a future night club.

There is planned music which will no doubt be loud with a thumping base beat keeping local residents awake as there is unlikely to be any soundproofing.

Why a food market needs such a late licence is difficult to understand, there is a similar venue in Southport which closes at 10pm.

We hope residents' concerns will be listened to and the application refused or amended to reasonable opening hours.
