9 LICENSING ACT 2003: SECTION 53A - INTERIM STEPS HEARING PENDING SUMMARY REVIEW OF PREMISES LICENCE

Consideration was given to information presented by Lancashire Constabulary, as contained on pages 9 to 12 of the Book of Reports, in respect of an application in relation to a Section 53A(l)(b) of the Licensing Act 2003, Pending a Review of a Premises Licence.

In considering this matter the Sub-Committee had regard to its Licensing Policy, the Licensing Act 2003 and the guidance issued under S. 182 of the Licensing Act. It considered the relevant Licensing Objectives on this occasion was the 'Prevention of Crime and Disorder'.
