**Subject:** Representation against the proposed new premises license application

Dear Sir/Madam,

I am writing to you to make a representation against the proposed new premises license application concerning 1 Palm Court Skelmersdale WN88PZ. The proposal is requesting opening hours of 07:00 to 23:00. Approval of this application will have a significant impact on myself and my property. There is no significant parking for a retail premises, and this will mean people will be parking in palm court making access in and out challenging. Also, I fear that the litter dropped by customers of the shop will be blown onto my property. In addition, I'm concerned about the noise levels that a shop with these opening hours will bring.

There are four convenience shops within 0.6 miles of the proposed premises and a supermarket that is 0.9 miles away. The addition of a new convenience store seems unnecessary. I believe approval of this application will increase the risk of public nuisance, on account of the below factors:

- Increased customer noise from inside and outside the premises
- Restricted road access
- Footpaths being blocked by parked cars
- Impact of deliveries and collections

Please consider my concerns when deciding on the application.
