This application for the review of a premise licence is being submitted by Lancashire Lancashire Constabulary, a responsible authority.

Despite police support and interventions the management of the premise has remained poor and failed to comply with the premise licence conditions.

The Constabulary believes that West Lancs Diner are undermining the Licensing Objectives of the Prevention of Crime & Disorder, public safety and prevention of public nuisance.

On Saturday 17th June 2023 Police received multiple calls, along with one from the owner regarding an 18th birthday party that had descended into a large public order incident at the front of the premises.

On 10th July 2023 Licensing Officers attend the premises and till data showed unauthorised transactions. The unannounced inspection was following recent complaints regarding the venue.

On Sunday 17th March 2024 a male was attacked with a pool cue and knocked unconscious in the premises. He suffered a fractured eye socket, nose and jaw. CCTV depicts the Offender leaving the scene with half a pool cue. This was a case of Section 18 Grievous Bodily Harm.

On 26th March 2024 a Licensing visit was conducted at the premises which identified Licensing Breaches in relation to Training records and Incident recording

On 6th June 2024 a Police Officer attended West Lancs Diner and discussed the importance of maintaining a safe environment during the Euro's. The DPS was handed a letter which amongst other considerations stated "use of polycarbonate or disposable drinkware for premises airing the fixtures"

On Saturday 6th July 2024 whilst patrons were watching Euro 24 an altercation took place at the bar area which resulted in one male receiving multiple slashing and puncture wounds with a glass. An individual then fled the premises and was followed and then attacked by unknown males armed with pool cues. He received significant injuries and both males required hospitalisation. The injuries sustained in both attacks are consistent with Section 18 Grievous Bodily Harm.
