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SUBJECT: HOUSING AND PLANNING ACT 2016: CIVIL PENALTIES & RENT

#### 1.0 PURPOSE OF THE REPORT

1.1 To seek authority to amend the Private Sector Housing Enforcement Policy in light of the new powers provided to Local Authorities under the Housing and Planning Act 2016 (the Act), specifically, civil penalties and rent repayment orders.

# 2.0 RECOMMENDATION

2.1 That authority be delegated to the Director of Leisure and Wellbeing, in consultation with the relevant Portfolio Holder, to amend the current Private Sector Housing Enforcement Policy to include civil penalties and rent repayment orders as outlined in the report submitted to Council on 18 October 2017, attached at Appendix A.

### 3.0 BACKGROUND

3.1 A report was considered by Council on 18 October 2017 advising of new powers provided to Local Authorities under the Housing and Planning Act 2016 specifically referring to civil penalties and rent repayment orders.

#### 4.0 CURRENT POSITION

4.1 The implementation of the new powers will require revisions to the current Private Sector Enforcement Policy which was originally approved by Cabinet.

- 4.2 Council referred the report to Cabinet in order for it to consider updating of the Policy to include appropriate coverage of the civil penalties and rent repayment orders referred to in the attached report at Appendix A.
