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SUBJECT: ITEM REFERRED FROM CABINET - FLOODING IN THE BOROUGH

1.0 PURPOSE OF THE REPORT

1.1 To advise on the decision of Cabinet at its meeting on 13 March 2018 in relation to an item referred from the Corporate and Environmental Overview and Scrutiny Committee Meeting on 4 January 2018 arising from a presentation at that meeting from United Utilities 'Flooding in the Borough'.

2.0 RECOMMENDATION

3.0 BACKGROUND

3.1 Minute 48 of the meeting of the Corporate & Environmental Overview and Scrutiny Committee on 4 January 2018 (outlined within Appendix A to this report) requested Cabinet to consider lobbying the government in relation to the reduction in funding for statutory services, in particular the general under investment in improving the waste sewerage systems.
